## NOTES FOR COMPLETING THE FORM

## Arranged by section number, as on the form overleaf

- 1. You must include all forenames, which are required for the marriage certificate and registers.
- 2. Please provide your age at the time of the marriage and not your age on application.
- 3. Please circle one of the options, and strike out the others that do not apply to you.

Single: you have never been married nor had a civil partnership

Widow/Widower: your marriage partner has died SCP: your civil partner has died

PMD/A: previous marriage dissolved/annulled

PCPD/A: previous civil partnership dissolved/annulled

- 4. Please be reasonably specific about the work and your level of responsibility. For example, for 'Sales' please indicate the commodity sold; for 'Contractor' indicate the industry (e.g. Building, Haulage); for 'Engineer' indicate the discipline (e.g. Civil, Consulting); for 'Civil Servant' indicate official rank plus the name of the Department (e.g. Administrative Officer, Ministry of Defence); for 'Fitter' indicate the kind of business (e.g. Motor Fitter, Boiler Fitter); for 'Labourer' indicate the business or service (e.g. Building Labourer, Agricultural Labourer); for 'Technician Technical Officer' etc. indicate any professional qualification in addition to the kind of service or business (e.g. Technical Assistant A.M.
